## From your pastor . . .

A blessed and happy Father's Day to all our fathers on this day that is set aside to acknowledge and express our gratitude for the many sacrifices you make on behalf of your family. We also remember our fathers who have passed from this life into the fullness of life. May they rest in peace.

In this column we continue with the presentation by Father John A. Hardon, S.J., founder of the Marian Catechist Apostolate on the Holy Eucharist as it appears in his <u>Catechism on the Real Presence</u> (printed in *italics*). Father Hardon refers often to the encyclical letter *Mysterium Fidei*, <u>The Mystery of Faith</u>, (MF), written by Pope Saint Paul VI. The catechesis in this column on the Holy Eucharist is meant to correspond with the National Eucharistic Revival that is taking place throughout the Dioceses in the United States.

# The Holy Eucharist: A Mystery of Faith

24. Is the Holy Eucharist a mystery of faith?

It is a great mystery of faith. This means it is a truth revealed by God which was inconceivable before revelation, and is incomprehensible, or not fully understood, even after being revealed. (MF 14)

25. How is the Eucharist a mystery of faith?

It is the mystery of faith because, as expressed by Pope Leo XIII, 'in it alone are contained a remarkable richness and variety of miracles, all supernatural realities." In other words, the Eucharist is a synthesis of all the mysteries of Christianity. (MF 14)

26. What is the root of the prevalent errors about the Holy Eucharist?

At the root of these errors is the virus of rationalism. The human reason is claimed to be the final arbiter of what is true. If we cannot comprehend something, even though revealed by God it should not be accepted by the human mind. (MF 15)

27. How should the mystery of the Eucharist be approached?

It should be approached with humble respect for the wisdom of God with firm adherence to divine revelation. In effect, it should not be dependent on the limitations of the human mind.

- 28. What is the role of St. John Chrysostom in the Church's teaching on the Eucharist?
- St. John Chrysostom is one of the greatest and earliest defenders of the Christian faith on the mystery of the Holy Eucharist. His instructions to the faithful are a model for all times.
- 29. How does St. John Chrysostom warn the faithful about questioning such mysteries as the Eucharist? His words deserve to be quoted in full: "Let us submit to God in all things and not contradict Him, even if what He says seems contrary to our reason and intellect; rather, let His words prevail over our reason and intellect. Let us act in this way with regard to the eucharistic mysteries, looking not only at what falls under our senses but holding on to His words. For His word cannot lead us astray." (MF 16)

Let us ask Father Hardon, who has been declared "Servant of God" (the first step toward canonization) to intercede on our behalf to our Lord, that an abundant rainfall will bless our countryside in the days to come. Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.




