From your pastor \dots

As you are aware, our governor has asked that we all wear face masks when we are gathered in a public place. I thank everyone for cooperating with this requirement. This past weekend, as much as I could see from the sanctuary, it appeared that everyone was wearing a mask. We have some available at each of the entrances if you happen to forget to bring yours with you to Mass.

I was asked if the church is required to follow this requirement insofar as the Church is a private and not a public institution. It is true that the Church is considered to be a private institution however we open our doors to the public to join us in worship and other religious services. By virtue of being open to the public, we are to follow the direction that comes from legitimate civil authority. The Governor's directive was immediately followed with Bishop Callahan's directive which mirrored that of the Governors. I reproduce the Bishop's directive here (appearing in bold type).

"On 14 May 2020 the Diocese of La Crosse issued Guidelines for the Public Celebration of Masses, effective 1 August 2020 this additional directive should be followed within the Diocese of La Crosse.

Face coverings are required when indoors or in enclosed space, other than private residence (Enclosed space is defined as a confined space, open to the public, where individuals congregate)

Face coverings are required when another person(s) who are not members of individual's household or living unit are present in the same room or enclosed space

Face coverings are required even if you are able to maintain proper social distancing

Face coverings must be worn to cover the nose and mouth completely

Face coverings should not include face shields, mesh masks or masks with holes, openings or vents

Exceptions are made for certain individuals who are exempt as outlined in the CDC guidance

Individuals may remove the face covering in the following situations:

While a single individual is giving a religious presentation, the single speaker may remove the face covering while actively speaking. While the face covering is removed, the speaker must remain at least 6 feet away from all other individuals at all times. (exception vi. – emergency order #1)

This directive is given in consideration of Executive Order #82, issued by Governor Evers on 30 July 2020, proclaiming a public health emergency and Emergency Order #1 and remains in place until 28 September 2020. All other previous issued directives and considerations of 14 May 2020 remain in place."

Finally, next Saturday, August 15th is our Parish Feast Day, The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a Holy Day but with no obligation accompanying it this year. There will be a Mass at 8:15 a.m. Also, the Mass at 5:15 p.m. that day will include the Rite of Confirmation. The majority of the seating space will be taken up by the Confirmandi, their sponsor and family members. I would ask those parishioners who normally attend the 5:15 Mass to consider attending one of the two Masses on Sunday instead.

Also, I will be available to hear the confessions of the Confirmandi on Friday evening in the Church from 5 to 7 p.m. This is an important opportunity for those to be confirmed to be prepared spiritually for the reception of the Holy Spirit through Confirmation.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish,


