

## From your pastor ...

As I indicated in last Sunday's column (with apologies to those who read these columns regularly) I will be repeating the columns that I have written in the past regarding the **Inspired by the Spirit** capital campaign. Because parishioners come and go on vacation during these summer months, I believe it to be prudent to reproduce some of my past columns so that those who may have missed them in the past are able to view them now. The **Inspired by the Spirit** campaign is diocesan-wide, taking place in all parishes, beginning here at Saint Mary's this month (August) and is scheduled to conclude in November.

Because this campaign is going to be reaching out to every parishioner, it is my intention through these columns to explain as much as possible so that it is not a surprise or a shock when it brought to everyone's attention with a request for a contribution/5-year pledge. The one thing that should be noted is that because of this campaign, the usual Diocesan Annual Appeal (DAA) that is conducted each year beginning in August is suspended for this year.

The Lynch Development Associated, Inc (LDA) firm was hired by the bishop to conduct this campaign after they did a feasibility study throughout the diocese in 2021 which gave a positive endorsement for a diocesan-wide campaign.

Having received the policies and procedures from Lynch, they involve the pastor in a significant way as well as members of the laity in the parish for providing leadership. Lynch also provides what is known as a "campaign director" who is assigned by their organization to assist the parish. Our campaign director is Jeff Mc Sweeney, who lives in La Crosse. Parishioners who will be serving in chairperson capacities are: Campaign Chairpersons - Julie and Paul Peckham; Major Gifts Chairperson - Deacon Donald Tully. Cheryl Blankenship will serve as the parish contact person. There will be more parishioners asked to participate in executing certain aspects of the campaign

In working together with enthusiasm and generosity, I believe that we have an opportunity to greatly improve our parish church by using the parish portion we raise in the campaign to finance the refurbishing of the nave (aisles, floor and pews). If the campaign goes well, we hope to begin the refurbishing project in January 2023 after the Christmas season. It will require 6-8 weeks to complete. More details describing this project will be forthcoming.

The **Inspired by the Spirit**, campaign, has assigned an amount to our parish that will be distributed -65% to the parish and 35% to Diocesan needs.

The assigned amount to our parish is \$480,000. The formula used to determine this amount (and is the same formula used in all the parishes of the Diocese) is as follows:

Reported Offertory of 2019 - 20\$391,276Reported Offertory of 2020 - 21\$421,658Divided by 2, multiplied by 1.17\$475,566Parish Campaign goal rounded up\$480,000Parish Share at 100% of Goal (65%)\$312,000Diocesan Share including 2022-23Diocesan Annual Appeal (35%)\$168,000

In future columns, I will continue to reproduce some of this information that has appeared before, but with any updates. If you have questions, you can submit them to me through the rectory or placing them in an envelope in the collection basket and I will attempt to answer them.
