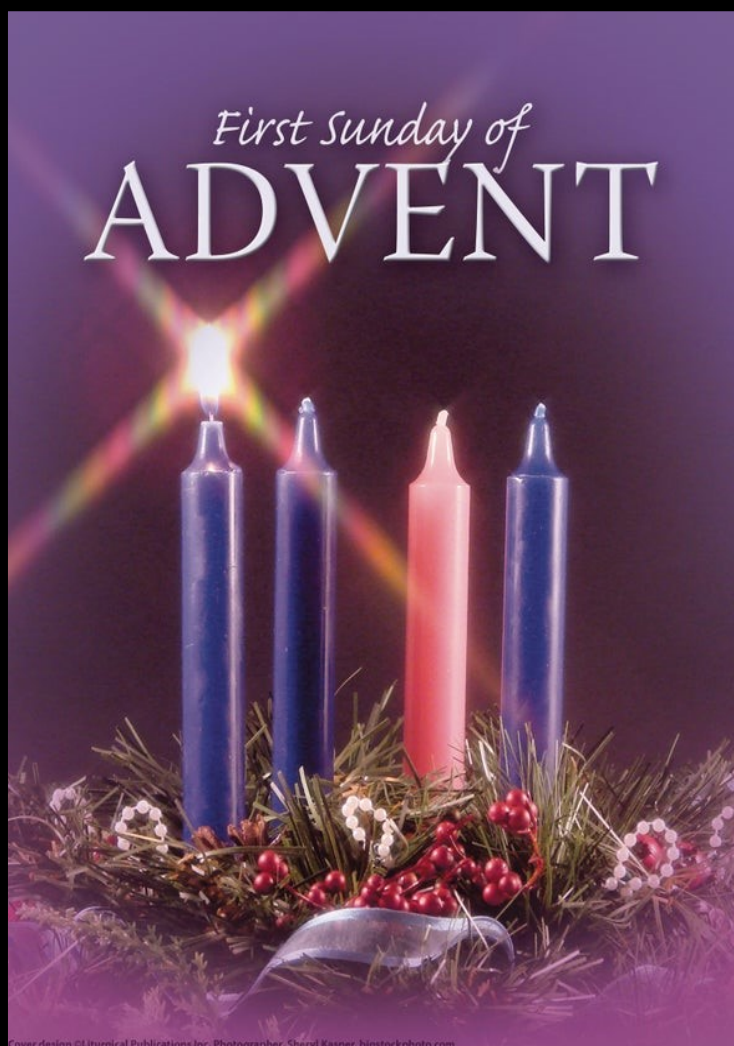

From your pastor . . .

The season of Advent is a penitential season that is to prepare for the coming celebration of the birthday of our savior at Christmas.

As Catholics we prepare in many different ways, but none more important than by seeking to purify our soul from sin through a good and holy confession. I make myself available in the confessional during extra hours so that you will have the opportunity to participate in this important Sacrament. Also, through the recommendation of the Diocese we have moved our First Confessions from the Season of Lent to Advent. This year the school students making their first confession will do so on Wednesday, December 15th. The Religious Education students will continue to make their First Confession during the Season of Lent. On the 15th of December, we are planning to have three extra priests in order to hear all the school students' confessions. If you would like to utilize this opportunity to confess to another priest, you could come to the Church on Wednesday, December 15 @11:00 a.m. and there should be a priest available to hear your confession.

Finally, please make note of the extended Advent confessional schedule that appears below as well as the Order for a Good Confession that you can bring with you to confession if so needed.

One hour before Sunday Masses, including the Christmas Masses.**

Priest: In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen

Penitent: Bless me Father for I have sinned. My last confession was _____ ago and these are my sins. (At this time make a complete confession of your sins.) . . . and I am sorry for these and all the sins of my life.

(The priest will give you words of counsel and assign your penance)

Penitent: (Recites this Act of Contrition or another) O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

Priest: (Recites the pray of absolution) **Penitent:** Amen.

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good.

Penitent: And His mercy endures forever.

Priest: The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.

(You now leave the confessional to carry out your assigned penance.)

O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. And I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments. But most of all because they offend you my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

Priest: (Recites the prayer of absolution) God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.

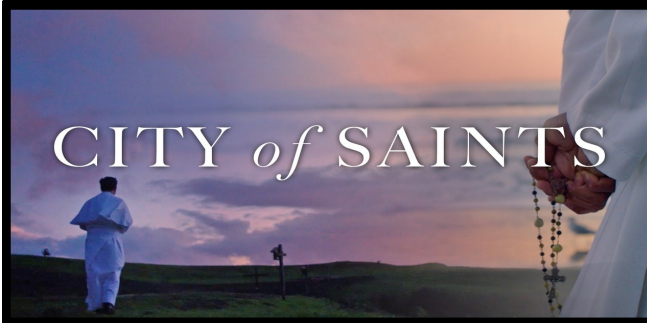
