From your pastor . . .

It happens at this time of the year that your generosity is greatly called upon in that the in the parish we have three major requests, all in the course of three months.

The first is the Diocesan Annual Appeal that usually begins in September and carries over into November and December. This year the Diocesan Annual Appeal has been included in the **Inspired by the Spirit** Capital Campaign which as I have mentioned we hope to have concluded by Thanksgiving.

The second request comes through what is known as the Missionary Co-op Appeal, whereby every parish in the diocese hosts a particular missionary who personally comes to the parish and makes an appeal. This year you make recall we hosted Father Thomas from Uganda, African. The response from our parish was overwhelmingly positive with a collection (that is still ongoing) that raised well over \$5,000 for his diocese's ministry in Uganda. You may recall that the collection for Father Thomas' appeal took place on October 15th and 16th.

The third request comes to every parish throughout the Universal Church in the form of the World Mission Sunday collection, which takes place each year on the fourth Sunday of November. Because this date was only once week after the Mission Cooperative appeal with Father Thomas, I chose to delay it to this next Sunday, November 12 -13.

To assist with this collection, an envelope has been attached to this Sunday's bulletin for your use. The giving envelopes you receive in the mail has one that is printed as "Propagation of the Faith," which is the same as the Mission Sunday Appeal.

While I know you are being asked to respond to various requests at this time, please respond to the Church's work through the missions by making a donation next Sunday. A second collection will be taken up after Holy Communion.

I take this opportunity to thank all who have contributed to the Inspired by the Spirit Campaign. We are closing in on the goal that was assigned to us by the Diocese of which over \$300,000 will be returned to our parish to finance the renovations that will take place in the nave after the Christmas season has concluded. I signed a contract with the pew company that will remove the pews, refinish them and then replace them back in the Church. Also, I signed the contract with the asbestos abatement company. Once I was able to surmise that we were having a successful capital campaign, it led to scheduling the firms that will be doing some of the work. The bigger contract is the one that involves the laying of the porcelain tile under the pews and in the aisles.

Again, thank you for contributing so that this project can go forward. If you have not yet made a pledge/donation, please do in the next couple of weeks. Thank you.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Church.
