From your pastor . . .

This Sunday we are having a second collection for what is known as World Mission Sunday. As I explained at the end of the Mass this past Sunday, this is a world-wide collection that is taken up in every Catholic Church. It is given a set date in the liturgical calendar of the fourth Sunday in October. We did not take up the collection on that Sunday this year because our parish was responding to the appeal that Monsignor Joseph Hirsch had made in our parish for support of Casa Hogar Orphanage, in Lurin, Peru, South America. Monsignor Hirsch had specifically asked if he could come to Saint Mary's in the fall rather than the summer, when the Mission Coop Appeal is ordinarily scheduled. He likes coming to Saint Mary's because of the generous response he receives. I try to accommodate his requests. However, by agreeing to his coming in October, it pushed up against the World Mission Appeal. Also, because the Diocese was a month late in getting the Diocesan Annual Appeal sent out, it also involves another extra request at the same time. I am sorry for this inconvenience. I would simply ask that you do the best you can in response to the requests. Thank you

November is the month that the Church directs our attention to our deceased love ones. This is because the first two days of the month are given over to All Saints Day and All Souls Day respectively. You may notice that the annual display that is made in front of the Blessed Mother altar is there for your prayerful consideration. It has a lit candle beside it (if the servers remember to light it before Mass.) There are two books: 1. Is a book that contains the names of those parishioners who died since All Souls Day in 2020. 2. The other book is a place for you to write the name of a deceased love one who was not buried from Saint Mary's Parish. We will remember them during the month of November.

Finally, I know people want to make plans for Christmas so I wish to include the Mass schedule for this coming Christmas of 2021. The Christmas Vigil Mass will be at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, December 24th, the Mass at Dawn and the Mass at Day will be celebrated respectively at 8:00 and 10:30 on Saturday, December 25. There will be no vigil Mass for the Feast of the Holy Family on Saturday, December 25th. There will be Masses for the Feast of the Holy Family on Sunday, December 26th at 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. I hope this helps with your planning.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.
