

Sportsman's Extravaganza Less than 2 weeks away, 4/27/24 From your pastor . . .

As has been widely reported, the Diocese of La Crosse will be receiving a new Bishop on Monday, May 20th when Bishop Gerard Battersby will be installed as the eleventh bishop of La Crosse at a Mass at the Cathedral (time is yet to be determined). I will use this column to present some aspects of his biography that have appeared in various new accounts.

Bishop Battersby is the youngest of 9 children along with his twin brother, born May 15, 1960. He grew up in northwest Detroit and attended Saint Benedict Parish and School in Highland Park.

Bishop Battersby graduated from Wayne State University in 1983 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology. He entered Sacred Heart Seminary in 1993 and received a Master of Divinity Degree in 1998. In 2009, he was assigned to graduate studies at the University of Saint Thomas (Angelicum) in Rome. He also earned Licentiate in Sacred Theology (STL) in the New Evangelization from the Angelicum through its partnership with Sacred Heart Seminary in Detroit.

Bishop Battersby currently serves as auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Detroit. He was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Detroit on May 30, 1998, Prior to his consecration as a bishop on January 25, 2017, he serves a Vice-Rector and Dean of Seminary Formation at Sacred Heart Major Seminary from 2011-2017; Director of Graduate Seminarians at Sacred Heart Major Seminary from 2007-2008; pastor of Saint Mary of Redford Parish, Detroit from 2015-2017; Administrator of Saint Leo Parish, Detroit from 2007-2008; pastor of Saint Christopher Parish, Detroit from 2002-2007; parochial vicar (associate pastor) of Presentation/Our lady of Victory Parish, Detroit from 2000-2002; parochial vicar (associate pastor) Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, 2000-2002; parochial vicar (associate pastor) of Saint Gerard Parish, Detroit from 2000-2002; and parochial vicar of Saint Thecia, Parish, Clinton Township from 1998-2000.

This is an important time for our diocese as we await the arrival of Bishop Battersby. Please pray for him in these coming days. We look forward to welcoming him to his new home and assignment.




