

# From your pastor . . .

Attached to the front of this bulletin is an important invitation for you to participate in what is known as a "synodal" process of consultation within the Church. I introduced this in a column approximately a month ago, but I wish again to bring it to your attention. Please take the time to read the attachment. This was prepared by the Parish Pastoral Council with the hope that you will respond to the invitation by January 10<sup>th</sup>. This can be done by calling the rectory and indicating who will be coming. Once we know how many people will be participating we will know how much time to allot each person for speaking. In all probability, it will be no more than five minutes and it could be less, depending on participation.

The date of the gathering here at Saint Mary's in the undercroft of the Church is February 5, 2022 from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. On that day, after you have given your testimony you will be free to leave if you do not want to remain and listen to the other testimonies. It will be possible for anyone who is unable to attend in person on that day, to submit a written testimony based on the nine themes or topics that appear on the invitation.

It is the Holy Father's desire that the Church attempt to reach out to people who may no longer participate at Mass. Please consider showing or giving this attachment to members of your family, neighbors or acquaintances whom you may know are no longer participating in the life of the Church. This attachment will also appear on the next bulletin that will be distributed at the Christmas Masses. Often there are many Catholics who are in attendance at those Masses that don't come throughout the year. Hopefully the invitation will reach them.

As we come ever closer to Christmas, please be mindful of the extra opportunities to participate in the Sacrament of Penance. There is no better way to be prepared for Christmas than having allowed God's mercy through absolution to wash and heal your soul. This past Wednesday, December 15<sup>th</sup>, the Catholic second graders in the school made their first Confession. It was a wonderful experience as their pastor to witness the excitement and careful preparation they exhibited for this holy occasion in their lives.



#### Order of Confession

**Priest:** In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen

Penitent: Bless me Father for I have sinned. My last confession was \_\_\_\_\_\_ ago and these are my sins. (At this point you make a complete confession of your sins to the best of your recollection.) . . . and I am sorry for these and all the sins of my life.

(The priest will give you words of counsel and assign your penance)

**Penitent:** (Recites this Act of Contrition or any other one they may wish to use) **O My God**, **I am heartily sorry for having offended you**. And **I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments. But most of all because they offend you my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin.** Amen.

**Priest:** (Recites the prayer of absolution) God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

#### Penitent: Amen.

**Priest:** Give thanks to the Lord for He is good.

Penitent: And His mercy endures forever.

**Priest:** The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.

(You now leave the confessional to carry out your assigned penance.)
