

From your pastor . . .

I take this occasion to wish all of you a blessed Christmas Day and Christmas season.

Thank you to those who made a contribution toward the poinsettias and other decorations that grace the church. Thank you to the generous parishioners who provided various items for our parish's Christmas Angel Gift program that have been distributed to those who are homebound and residents of nursing homes. Thank you to those parishioners who have sent to the rectory Christmas cards, presents or a plate filled with many tasty calories.

Please remember that Christmas does not end the night of December 25th but continues until the Feast of the Baptism of our Lord which is celebrated this year on Sunday, January 9th. In between are the feast days of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph – Dec. 26th, Mary, Mother of God – January 1st, and the Epiphany – Sunday, Jan.2nd. Attempt to teach your children the mysteries of the Christian Faith by maintaining the Christmas spirit throughout the entire Christmas season.

Attached to the front of this bulletin is an important invitation for you to participate in what is known as a "synodal" process of consultation within the Church. Please take the time to read the attachment. This was prepared by the Parish Pastoral Council with the hope that you will respond to the invitation by January 10th. This can be done by calling the rectory and indicating who will be coming. Once we know how many people will be participating we will know how much time to allot each person for speaking. In all probability, it will be no more than five minutes and it could be less, depending on participation.

The date of the gathering here at Saint Mary's in the undercroft of the Church is Saturday, February 5, 2022 from 9:00-11:00 a.m. On that day, after you have given your testimony you will be free to leave if you do not want to remain and listen to the other testimonies. It will be possible for anyone who is unable to attend in person on that day, to submit a written testimony based on the nine themes or topics that appear on the invitation.

It is the Holy Father's desire that the Church attempt to reach out to people who may no longer regularly participate at Mass. If you are reading this column and are aware that you are participating less in the life of the Church that in past years, perhaps only on Christmas and Easter, the Holy Father would like to hear your testimony. Please consider coming on Saturday, February 5th but please call the rectory at 647-2621 to reserve a place. Thank you for considering this request.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish during throughout this holy season of Christmas.


