From your pastor . . .

Today we celebrate Guadete (Rejoice!) Sunday. It is always celebrated on the Third Sunday of Advent and is signaled by the lighting of the rose candle in the Advent wreath. The reason we rejoice is that this is when we make the 'turn' in the Advent season from anticipating the second and final coming of our Lord (first two Sundays of Advent) to the coming that has already taken place in history (last two Sundays of Advent) – our Lord's coming having been born of the Blessed Virgin May on the First Christmas.

Another good reason for us to REJOICE as a parish is that as was (or will be) announced at today's Masses, we have met and surpassed the Inspired by the Spirit Campaign goal of \$480,000 that was assigned to us. Order for Making a Good Confession

Priest: In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen

Penitent: Bless me Father for I have sinned. My last confession was ______ ago and these are my sins. (At this point you make a complete confession of your sins to the best of your recollection.) ... and I am sorry for these and all the sins of my life.

(The priest will give you words of counsel and assign your penance)

Penitent: (Recites this Act of Contrition or any other one they may wish to use) O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. And I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments. But most of all because they offend you my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

Priest: (Recites the prayer of absolution) God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen.

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good.

Penitent: And His mercy endures forever.

Priest: The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.



St Mary of the Assumption Church and School Will be collecting donations for our local nursing homes. Containers will be located at the church entrance and school.


Please put the items in the box prior to December 16th.


