

Tuesday December 21st - 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Wednesday, December $22^{nd} - 4:00 - 6:00$ p.m.

Thursday, December 23rd - 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.

Friday, December 24th - 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.

Saturday, December 24th - 3:15 p.m. - 3:45

Confessions will be heard before the Midnight Mass and the 9:00 a.m. Christmas Day Mass

Order for Making a Good Confession

Priest: In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen

Penitent: Bless me Father for I have sinned. My last confession was
______ ago and these are my sins. (At this point you make a complete confession of your sins to the best of your recollection.) ...
and I am sorry for these and all the sins of my life.

(The priest will give you words of counsel and assign your penance)

Penitent: (Recites this Act of Contrition or any other one they may wish to use) O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. And I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments. But most of all because they offend you my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

Priest: (Recites the prayer of absolution) God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen.

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good. **Penitent: And His mercy endures forever.**

Priest: The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.

(You now leave the confessional to carry out your assigned penance.)
