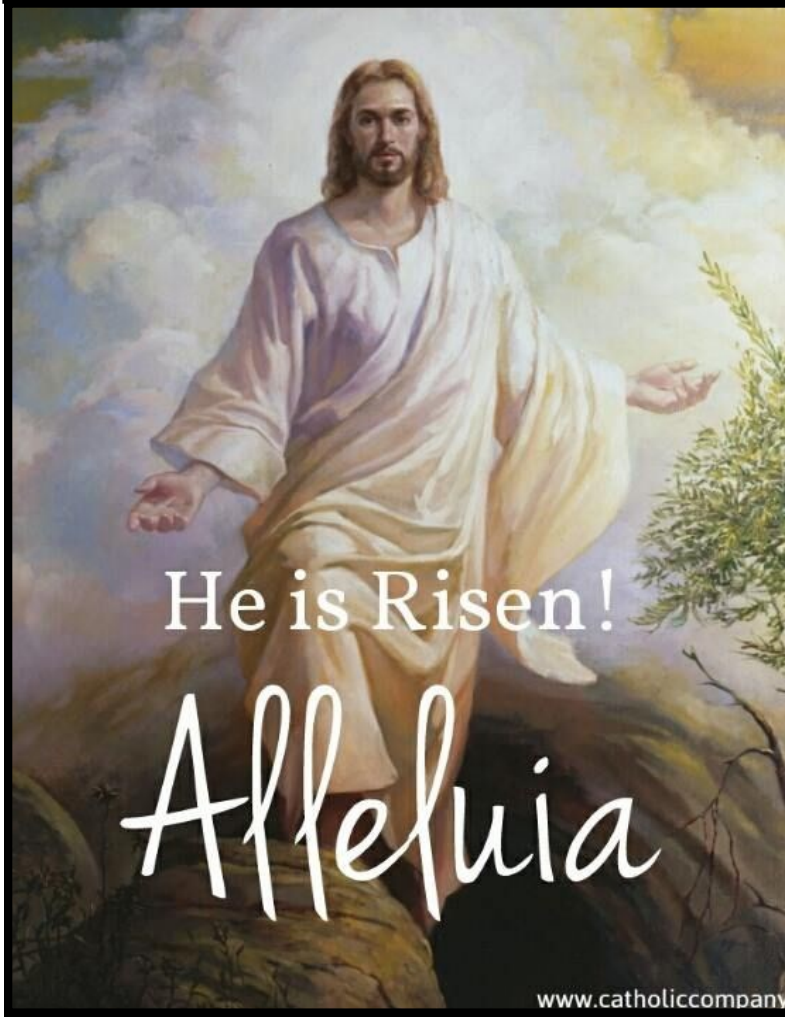

From your pastor . . .

Alleluia! At this time I am still in the process of healing from the knee replacement surgery that I underwent on Saint Patrick's Day, March 17. The surgery seemed to go well and I was able to return back to the rectory the same day that surgery took place. The next morning the pain block that had been used for the surgery had worn off and I was quickly transported into a very different reality of pain and discomfort. I have had to use the pain medication given to me to keep the pain from becoming too intense. The incision seems to be healing well which is important in that it would be through it that an infection could enter into the knee. Please keep me in your prayers so that I will be completely healed and return back to my pastoral duties.

I am planning at this time (Monday of Holy Week) to celebrate the Triduum – the three days of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. It will be at the Easter Vigil that we shall welcome Ryan Tydrich into the fullness of the Faith, through his Profession of the Faith, followed by the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Communion. By the time you are reading this, God willing that wonderful reception will have taken place and you can greet Ryan as our newest adult member.

I extend a very special thanks to Deacon Tully who has assisted me greatly in the sanctuary throughout this time of recuperation and express a particular gratitude to Mari Lu Marshall who has accomplished the beautiful decorating of the Church. Thank you to all who donated toward the flowers which express outwardly the wonder and beauty that is in our hearts as we celebrate in the days to come the wonderful season of Easter.

May you, along with your family and loved ones experience a blessed Easter Sunday.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary Parish.
