

## From your pastor . . .

I take this occasion to wish all mothers a very happy and joy filled Mother's Day. Your generosity and love for your family is one of the most important signs that we have in this life of God's love for each of us. For those of us who have had to say goodbye to our mothers who have left this world, let us never forget them in our prayers as well as to ask for their intercession on our behalf.

Congratulations to the young people of our parish who were confirmed this past Thursday by Bishop Callahan at the Church of the Annunciation of Mary in Viroqua. It was good to finally see our Bishop after the COVID restrictions over the past years. You may recall that for the past two years, Bishop Callahan had asked pastors to carry out the Rite of Confirmation in the parish.

This next Sunday, May 15<sup>th</sup> at the 10:30 a.m. Mass, First Holy Communion will be celebrated by 15 of our younger parishioners. There will be a practice at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. Confessions will be made available after the practice for any parents or family members who may wish to receive this sacrament in preparation for the next day.

A special thank you to the many parishioners who help to carry out the Sportsman's Extravaganza this past Saturday at the Richland Center Community Center. It required a good amount of work to hold such an event that attracts a significant crowd of people, mostly from outside the area. The winner of the drawing for the hunting land or \$25,000 cash was John Burrel from Appleton, Wisconsin. He is deciding whether to take the land or the cash. He is making a trip to personal view the property this next week and then will inform us of his decision. I cautioned him that the snow may not yet be melted in the northern part of the state. He was very happy to have won and said that he has been buying tickets for many years.

Just a reminder to those of you who took home the blue Lydia House banks on Ash Wednesday (or sometime in Lent) that if you have not yet done so to please return them to the church. You can place them directly in the collection basket when it comes around if you so choose. Earlier in the year, I committed our parish to an annual contribution of \$2500 to the Lydia House Ministries to cover their annual expenses. What you contribute through the Blue Houses will go toward paying that commitment.

The Lydia House Ministries is an ecumenical outreach, particularly for the temporary homeless begun by the Richland Center Ministerial Association. I serve as the Vice-President of the Lydia House Ministries as well as the treasurer of the Ministerial Association. I tell you this so that you can have confidence in giving to this ecumenical endeavor.

Finally, a reminder to our graduating students from high school and the Catholic elementary school, that a Sunday Mass for graduates will take place on Sunday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> at the 10:30 Mass. High school graduates are asked, if possible, to wear their cap and gown. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation Mass with distribution of diplomas will take place on Tuesday, May 31<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 p.m.
