

Pope Francis Wants to Hear from You

Pope Francis wants to hear from anyone who is willing to share his or her experience as a Catholic, present or past. If you wish to participate, you are invited to a gathering on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>February 5, 2022 from 9:00 a.m.</u> to 11:00 a.m. in the undercroft of Saint Mary's Church.

This gathering will be one of thousands that will take place in parishes of the Diocese of La Crosse and in all of the dioceses of the United States as well as the entire world. This is a participation in what is known as a Synod, a means by which the entire Church comes together in prayer and community to provide input to the Pope and the Bishops of the Catholic Church.

If you have ever desired to provide your personal perspective to the Catholic Church this is a good opportunity to do so. <u>If you decide to participate</u>, please contact the rectory 608-647-2621 or email roger.scheckel@stmarysrc.com by January 10, 2022 for a reservation.

Below are some themes or topics to which you may wish to respond. You can choose as few or as many as you would like. When considering your participation, it is most desirable that you share from the vantage point of your personal experience rather than give a response that may come from the Church's teaching. The Pope and Bishops know what the Church teaches. They want to know your experience as a Catholic.

- 1. Would you be willing to share your present or past experience of being a member of the Catholic Church?
- 2. Have you experienced being listened to as a participating member of the Church? Has your experience or opinion been appreciated by others?
- 3. Do you have experiences of sharing openly and honestly in the Church and being genuinely heard and considered?
- 4. Do you have experiences of friendships and companionship that have formed through your participation in the Church? Do you know of those who seem to be left out from such relationships?

 What is your experience with those who live "on the margins" of the Church and society?
- 5. Have you been welcomed to become engaged with the mission of the Church?
- 6. Would you be willing to share your experience of working together with members of the Church and/or with others who are not Catholic?
- 7. Do you have experiences of when you were involved in decisions that provided direction to the Church?
- 8. In your participation in the Church, have you experienced the closeness and companionship of Jesus Christ?
- 9. Is there anything else you would like to share with the Pope and Bishops?
