

### From your pastor...

This column continues with a partial reproduction of the <u>Catechism on The Real Presence</u> by Servant of God Father John A. Hardon, S.J. The abbreviation (MF) after some of the answers is a reference to the encyclical *Mysterium Fidei* (Mystery of Faith) promulgated by Pope Paul VI on September 3, 1965. These installments from Father Hardon's Catechism are meant to assist in a deeper understanding and appreciation of the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist as the Catholic Church in the United States engages in a National Eucharistic Revival.

We take up where we left off last week with the question, "What are the statements of some of the Fathers of the Church?", Question 92.

Saint Cyril of Alexandria wrote, "Christ said indicating (the bread and wine): 'this is My Body:' and This is My Blood,' in order that you might not judge what you see to be a mere figure. The offerings by the hidden power of God Almighty, are changed into Christ's Body and Blood, and by receiving these we come to share in the life-giving and sanctifying efficacy of Christ," (MF 60).

Finally, Saint Ambrose, Bishop of Milan, speaking of the Eucharistic change, says: "Let us be assured that this is not what nature formed, but what the blessing consecrated, and that greater efficacy resides in the blessing than in nature, but for the blessing nature is changed." Then Ambrose adds what every Catholic should memorize: "Surely the word of Christ, which could make out of nothing that which did not exist, can change things already in existence into what they were not. For it is no less extraordinary to give things new natures than to change their natures," (MF 61).

93. What is the Credo of the Eucharist which expresses our faith in the Real Presence?

The following Credo was written by Saint Gregory VII to be professed by the heretic Berengarius in 1079. "I believe in my heart and openly profess that the bread and wine which are placed upon the altar are, by the mystery of the sacred prayer and the words of the Redeemer, substantially changed into the true and life-giving flesh and blood of Jesus Christ Our Lord, and that after the consecration, there is present the true Body of Christ which was born of the Virgin and offered up for the salvation of the world, hung on the Cross and now sits at the right hand of the Father, and that there is present the true Blood of Christ which flowed from His side. They are present not only by means of a sign and of the efficacy of the Sacrament, but also in the very reality and truth of their nature and substance."

94. What councils of the Church have been especially clear in defining the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist?

They are the Councils of Lateran IV (1215), Constance (1414-1418), Florence (1431-1445), and Trent (1545-1563), (MF 64).

95. What major heresy after the Council of Trent undermined the doctrine of the Real Presence?

It was Jansenism, which originated with the heretical bishop Jansensius (1585-1638) and was promoted by the heretical Bishop Scipione de Ricci at the Synod of Pistoia (1786), (MF 65).

I hope that your Lent is bearing good spiritual fruit in your life. Please remember the Mass that is celebrated on Fridays at 5:15 p.m., preceded by confessions and followed by the Way of the Cross.




STATIONS OF THE CROSS
