We will take a break from the question-and-answer format of Father John A. Hardon's <u>Catechism on the Real Presence</u>, to underscore some upcoming events and ongoing programs taking place within the parish.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a program for those who wish to enter the Catholic Faith. It is for unbaptized adults as well as for those who are baptized but who wish to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church. Also, it is a program for Catholics who may have never received the Sacrament of Confirmation and who wish to do so, as well as for any Catholic who wishes to grow in knowledge of the Catholic religion. This year's course will be presented by Deacon Don and Susan Tully. You can contact Deacon Tully by emailing him at donald.tully@stmarysrc.com or you can contact Saint Mary's rectory at 608-647-2621. Please spread the word about this upcoming program (it will begin in September) to anyone who you know that has expressed interest in the Catholic Faith.

FORMED, is a program that Saint Mary's Parish makes available free of charge to any and all parishioners. It is directed by the Augustine Institute and makes available via the internet a great amount of excellent Catholic material. In each publication of the bulletin, you can find the directions as to how to subscribe to this service. When it asks for what parish, you belong to be certain to use the 53581-zip code of Richland Center, so that they connect you with the correct St. Mary's Church. I encourage you to give FORMED a try if you haven't done so. Take some time and scroll through all the various programs that are available for children and adults. You can trust what is presented through FORMED as being authentically Catholic.

Father-Son Annual Banquet sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, Council 3492 is scheduled on Wednesday, September 6, 2023 and will be held at The Phoenix Center (bowling alley) in Richland Center. The social begins at 6:00 p.m., the dinner at 6:30 and will conclude with a blessing at 8:00 p.m. The guest speaker will be Monsignor Donald Heiar who grew up in Richland Center, attending Saint Mary's Parish and graduating from the Catholic grade school. He was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Madison in May of 2000. He is currently the pastor of a newly formed pastorate comprising seven parishes in the tri-county area of Dane, Jefferson and Rock counties. Tickets for adults are \$15 and for those 10 and under - \$8.00. 




