

From your pastor . . .

As we get closer to the celebration of Christmas, a reminder of the schedule for the Christmas Masses as well as the extended schedule for confessions.

As you may have already noticed, this year is a little unusual in that with Christmas appearing on a Monday, this means that the vigil Christmas Mass will take place on Sunday, December 24th in the early evening at 4:00 p.m. There will be two Masses offered for the Fourth Sunday of Advent on that same Sunday, December 24th at the usual times of 8:00 and 10:30 a m. It is important to note that attending the Christmas vigil Mass does not satisfy the obligation for worshiping on the Fourth Sunday of Advent. To satisfy that obligation you must attend the Saturday (December 23rd) Vigil Mass or one of the Masses offered on Sunday (December 24th) morning.

There are three Christmas Masses scheduled. The Vigil Mass at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, the 12:00 a.m. Midnight Christmas Mass on Monday and a 9:00 a.m. Christmas Day Mass on Monday.

Christmas Day Mass will not use incense while the vigil and midnight Masses will use incense.

In the past, the Vigil Christmas Mass was quite full, in that it seems to be a favorable time for families with young children. You may want to be cognizant of this especially if you are elderly or attending with an elderly family member, so that you arrive a little early to have a place to sit. During the Christmas celebration when COVID was a problem, the attendance was not that significant, but last Christmas the attendance decisively increased, and I suspect it will increase even more this year.

I have already published the extended times for Advent confessions, but I will do so again below as well as the Order for Making a Good Confession that is used here at Saint Mary's. Frequently people will clip it and bring it with them to the confessional to assist in making their confession. While I list a time when Confessions end, I will remain in the confessional for as long as there are penitents waiting in the Church.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.

Wednesday, December 20th – 5:00 – 6:00 p.m. Thursday, December 21 – 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. Friday, December 22 – 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Order for Making a Good Confession

Priest: In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen

Penitent: Bless me Father for I have sinned. My last confession was ______ ago and these are my sins. (At this point you make a complete confession of your sins to the best of your recollection.) ... and I am sorry for these and all the sins of my life.

(The priest will give you words of counsel and assign your penance)

Penitent: (Recites this Act of Contrition or any other one they may wish to use) O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. And I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments. But most of all because they offend you my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

Priest: (Recites the prayer of absolution) God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen.

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good. **Penitent: And His mercy endures forever**.

Priest: The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God. (You now leave the confessional to carry out your assigned penance.)
